The Cambridge Program at Falcon Cove Middle School:

The Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) is a rigorous, internationally recognized course of study for academically talented and motivated students. The AICE program, also known as “Cambridge”, has been in existence for over 150 years, and is under the sponsorship of Cambridge University in England. The Cambridge curriculum for the middle school level is known as “Secondary I”, and offers a wide range of classes.

Falcon Cove welcomed its first group of 7th grade Cambridge students in Fall 2014, and expanded over the past few years to include all grade levels at the school.

The Cambridge curriculum is taught in over 9000 schools in 160 different countries worldwide, and is recognized as the largest provider of international qualifications for 11-19 year old students. In the United States, there are more than 250 Cambridge schools since the institution of the American program in 1990.

Cambridge courses at FCMS aim to assist each student to become a “Citizen of the World”

The program emphasizes independent thinking, research, group work, quest for knowledge and verification of ideas, debate, public speaking, and ownership of academics. Students are asked to continuously keep up with world events and relate them to the curriculum taught in the classroom. All teachers meticulously intertwine Cambridge’s “Scheme of Work” with Florida Standards to guarantee all Cambridge students are even more prepared for the demands of the Florida standardized testing, and the continued expected path in high school.

Continuing the Cambridge education in high school is not mandatory for Cambridge students and vice versa, students who have not enrolled in the Cambridge program in middle school may choose the Cambridge path in high school.

However, the Cambridge Secondary I teaching and learning style implemented at Falcon Cove is invaluable for student success at all levels of high school education.

Cambridge Program Selection:

The Cambridge program at Falcon Cove Middle is a highly selective program for academically advanced students, and requires the following from each applicant:

- Completed application
- A level 4 or 5 in both the Reading and Math sections of the FSA
- Exemplary citizenship
- A grade of “A” or “B” in all courses during the application year
- Strong recommendations from the current English, Science and Social Studies teachers
- A passing score on the essay writing entrance exam
